There will be sausage rolls available from the canteen this Friday, 8 December. There is a limited amount available, so it's first in first served.

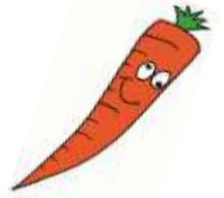
Also the following Friday, 15 December is the last canteen day for 2017. There will only be sandwiches and ice blocks available for lunch and recess items will be limited.
