The days and opening times are:

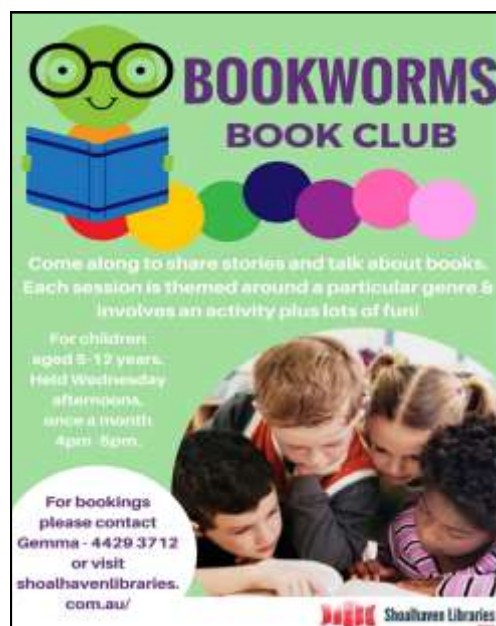
