They organise interactive video conferencing with some famous Australian authors, as well as some very well known international guests.

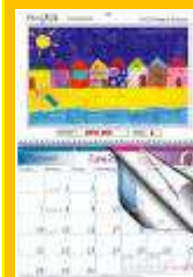
This year the authors included; Jackie French, Aaron Blabey, Mem Fox, Leigh Hobbs, Lauren Child, Jeff Kinney and many more!

Each product will have your child's artwork printed in colour and is a great present or item to hold on to!



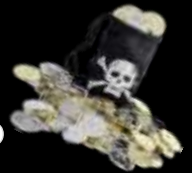
