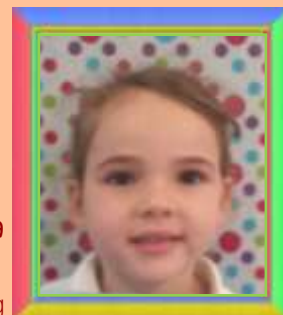
## Fairley
