Parent Online Payments

This is a reminder to our parents and carers that payment for school activities can be made through our Parent Online Payment service. This service provides a convenient and secure method of paying for school based activities. Parents who use the service already will have noticed some changes to the site recently.

During June, Westpac made a number of improvements, making it easier to use, these include:

- Collapsible sections have grouped information in a more logical order
- Browser auto-fill allows parents to make payments without having to re-enter details
- There is more time to enter details
- Larger controls makes it easier to use on mobile screens and
- Payment options include via credit card or direct debit from a bank account.

Produce Buy and Sell Stall

Tall Trees Before and After School Care have begun their own 'Produce Buy and Sell Stall'. The idea of a stall was created after the children were talking about how lots of people seem to grow things and that they have a lot more than they can eat. They came up with the idea that they could run a little stall that buys produce from people and sells it on (a bit like a second hand book stall!).
