A permission note has been sent home today regarding the School Swimming Scheme. This program is for students in Years 1 to Year 4.

The Scheme will commence on Monday 17 September and conclude on Friday 28 September (Weeks 9 & 10 of this term). Students will travel by bus to and from the Bay and Basin Leisure Centre over the two week period and participate in daily 45 minute lessons. The lessons are free of charge and are provided by qualified AUSTSWIM teachers. There is a cost of \$85 which covers bus transport and pool entry.
